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BUILD A POSITIVE COMMUNITY

Create with Empathy
Consider how their videos & comments might be received. ✓

Be Inclusive
Confirm that their content doesn't offend or exclude anyone. ○

Think Critically
Detect misinformation to ensure what they say/share is true. ○

Prevent Cyberbullying
Remind them to avoid (or report) bullying & digital drama. ○

CITIZENSHIP

Empower your teen to be a good digital citizen who considers the impact of their actions on themselves and others.



SAFETY

As an ally in their content creation journey, you can help them prioritize their safety and privacy while nurturing their creative expression.



BEWARE OF THE OVERSHARE

Set Boundaries
Discuss what info is or isn't safe to share. ✓

Review Privacy Settings
Decide where their videos will appear & who can see them. ○

Check the Details
Ensure their words, clothes, or locations don't reveal private info. ○

Get Consent
Confirm that everyone they show or mention gave the OK. ○

Consider the Impact
Remind them to
PAUSE > ASSESS RISK > MAKE THE CALL ○
